SUMMER SCIENCE SCHOLARS INSTITUTE

The Paper Discovery Center invites any high school student entering junior or senior year in September to apply for this program. We want to provide you with an experience to explore some STEM (Science, technology, engineering and math) careers and develop your skills in science, communication, research, teamwork, and problem solving.

Dates: Monday, Tuesday, & Friday for 2 weeks in a row at the end of July / early August.

(July 28, 29, and Aug 1, 4, 5, & 8th)

Time: 9:00 am – 3:00 pm on Mondays & Tuesdays, 9:00-12:00 on Fridays.

Cost: \$100

Scholarships: Upon satisfactory completion, each participant is eligible for a \$75 scholarship. A \$100 scholarship would be available to those showing financial need.

The program will include a maximum of 20 students entering junior or senior year from schools across Northeast Wisconsin. Acceptance will be based upon application review. The participating students are expected to be interested in science.

The workshop will include: an in-depth look at science application within paper-related industries, videos and tours of the paper making and converting processes, and an opportunity to teach younger students what you've learned by leading groups through the science center exhibits and a paper making activity. Participants will also have a chance to work as a team using resources on-site, to create and make a science-based exhibit for the Paper Discovery Center. The name of each team member will be honored and displayed on a plaque alongside the exhibit.

Throughout the workshop you'll be able to partake in luncheons, career presentations, and panel discussions with science professionals – chemists, engineers, foresters, etc. It's guaranteed to be a great experience which can help you decide upon a field of study in college. Participation in the program will be a great opportunity to build your college resume.
