Working: Man, Woman, & Machine



Working: Man, Woman, & Machine, a unique exhibit featuring the art of former Lawrence University artist-in-residence Thomas Dietrich, showcases the men, women, and machines involved in making paper. Eleven paintings of circa 1950s papermaking operations at Appleton's former Fox River Paper mill (now part of Neenah Paper, Inc.) detail the process. An additional preliminary compositional print made by Thomas Dietrich on site at the Fox River Paper mill is on display, courtesy of **Bob Buchanan**, former chairman of Fox River Paper Co. Captured memories of former and current paper industry workers are displayed. Visiting retirees and workers are invited to share their own memories. Also included are artifacts representative of the papermaking process from the Paper Discovery Center collection. The exhibit opens September 24, 2007, and is on display through February 2, 2008. Come and view the paper industry's great heritage.



Lawrence University Papermaking Marathon

The paper they made will be used for gift shop merchandise at the Paper Discovery Center. We thank **Lawrence University** for their partnership and hope to see these upperclassmen and -women, and the students they work with, return in a volunteer capacity.

Field Trip Funding Opportunity

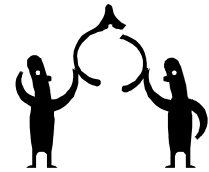
