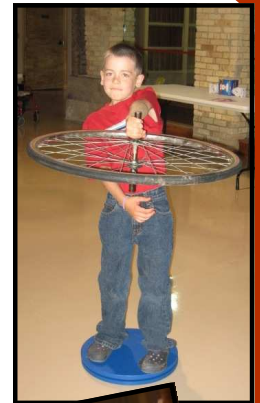

Fiberscapes: Experiencing Paper in 3-D

Exhibit-goers wearing 3-D glasses take an exciting walk inside a sheet of paper. A section of paper smaller than a period at the end of a sentence, is blown up into images which show the enlarged fibers.

These images, projected on the walls and floor, surround the visitors and invite them to reach out for the fibers before them. A variety of handmade paper is included in the exhibit, including paper made from cattails, corn husks, silk, and more. So far four sponsors have been identified for **Fiberscapes: Experiencing Paper in 3-D**: Community First Credit Union, Voith Paper, We Energies, and Willems Marketing. The exhibit will be running throughout the school year and field trips can include a special viewing of the exhibit.

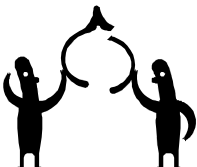
