Cost \$425/person and includes a light continental breakfast and lunch.

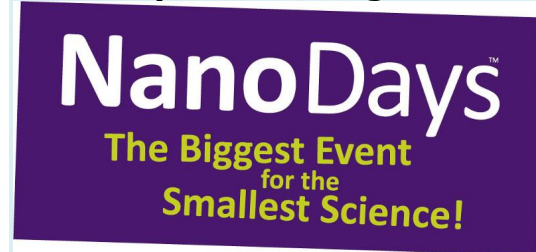

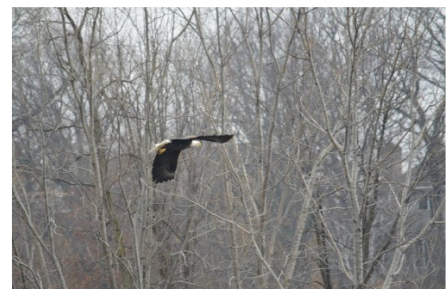
### **Nano Days are Coming Back!**
