Nominations are being accepted for induction into the Paper Industry International Hall of Fame. The deadline for submitting a nomination form is **March 31, 2013.**

The inductee will be an individual(s), **who has pioneered and/or helped the world's paper and allied industries to flourish.** Recognition will be based on contributions in these categories:

Academic, Economics, Entrepreneur, Founder, Leadership, Marketing/Sales, Research & Development, Service and Technology.

Nomination forms are available online at www.paperhall.org/nominations.php. They are also available at the Paper Discovery Center at 425 W. Water Street, Appleton, WI 54911 or by calling 920-380-7491. Nomination papers may be mailed, or submitted electronically. If submitted electronically, the cover sheet with the original signatures of the two nominating sponsors must be mailed to the office. Nominations will not be considered complete until original signatures from the nominators have been received.

Nominations that have been received within the past four years remain eligible for selection; however, it is essential that all information contained in the applications be updated. Names and addresses of the candidate and the sponsors need to be current. **Please review your copy if you have submitted a nomination and correct it if necessary.**

The 2013 Induction Ceremony will be held in Appleton, Wisconsin on October 3, 2013 at the Radisson Paper Valley Hotel.

“Paper is at the heart of education, communication, information and innovation”, said Donna Harmon, the keynote speaker for the 18th annual PIIHF Induction Ceremony. Ms. Harmon is the President and Chief Executive Officer of the American Forest & Paper Association (AF&PA) and is recognized by industry leaders and policy makers alike as one of the leading experts on public policy concerning the forest products industry. She has been recognized by Pulp and Paper International magazine as one of the 50 most influential people in the global pulp and paper industry.

Ms. Harmon spoke of the constantly evolving paper industry that has historically relied on innovation to maintain economic viability and sustainability. Today, the paper industry is a leader in energy efficiency and the efficient production of renewable energy. The rate of recovery of paper products was 66.8% last year, surpassing the recovery rate for glass, plastic and steel combined. 70% more trees are planted than are harvested each year, with the industry planting 3 million trees every day. “Better Practices, Better Planet 2020” - AF&PA’s sustainability initiative - is a proactive commitment to the long-term success of the pulp and paper industry, communities, environment and the nearly 900,000 men and women who make the paper and wood products vital to the lives of people around the world.

The induction ceremony celebrated the achievements of Ernst Behrend, Arnold Grummer, Erling Lorentzen, Hannu Paulapuro, Louis-Nicolas Robert and Juuso Walden as these men joined the other 105 inductees in the Hall of Fame. 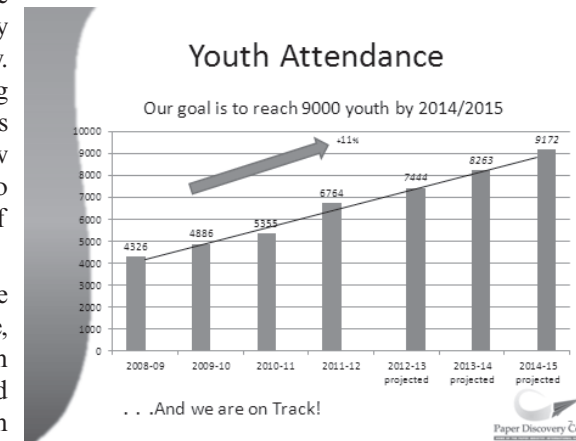
Celebrating the Wonder of Paper with STEM

As the Paper Discovery Center enters its ninth year, our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) education programs continue to grow in popularity as we strive to gain recognition in the community as a dynamic center of STEM based learning. We are uniquely positioned to offer STEM educational opportunities within the context of the culture, technology and science of the Paper Industry. Our vision is to provide engaging and memorable learning experiences for Fox Valley youth. As we grow our programs, we are on track to reach 9,000 youth/year by the end of the 2014-15 school year.

Kids have fun at the PDC, and leave wanting to experience more science, technology, engineering and math. In 2012, we had a 17% increase in field trip attendance, a 15% increase in Scout Workshop participation, and a 24% increase in attendance for our Summer Science Series. In all, we brought a STEM learning experience to 6,760 youth 2012. New educators Jennifer Breining, Amber Hamilton

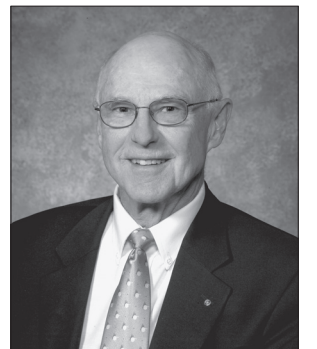

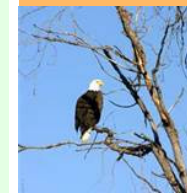

Coming in April - an amazing ten foot tall paper sculpture. Power Tower will be on display at the Paper Discovery Center during April and May 2013. Also on display will be additional paper sculptures by the same artist. Power Seeker is a survey of cut paper sculpture by the artist Michael Velliquette. Working exclusively with heavyweight paper card stock, Velliquette hand cuts and constructs visually and structurally complex forms, which reference masks and other forms of ritually driven object making.
