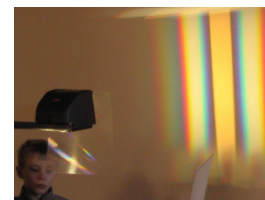
Dear Friends,

## The Paper Industry is a very Green Industry

**The Paper Industry does not destroy forests.**

People mistakenly believe that the Paper Industry destroys forests. This is not true. In the USA, about 4-million trees are planted every day with 1.7 million being planted by the Paper Industry. There are 750 million acres of forests in the United States, about the same as 100 years ago, but their net growth is 36% higher. About 11% of the timber felled throughout the world is used to make paper. Planting new trees can significantly help to combat global warming. For every ton of wood a forest produces, it removes 1.47 tons of CO<sub>2</sub> from the air and replaces it with 1.07 tons of oxygen.



Paper is made from many forms of cellulose. Cellulose is the most abundant organic compound on the planet and is employed to create products we use each and every day. What other industry sustainably harvests a totally renewable resource using an amazingly efficient process, and then converts it into products that every person needs in order to be well educated, well informed, hygienic and comfortable?
