The Paper Discovery Center is a member of the Fox Valley Scout Program Collaboration

- All programs require pre-registration and prepayment.
- Fee for each program is \$8/scout, unless otherwise noted.
- Siblings over age 6 may attend for \$8/child, but they must be registered in advance.
- These programs are not appropriate for children under age 6.
- There are no refunds for cancellations, however substitutes are permitted.
- Scouts must be accompanied by leaders and/or parent chaperones. There is never a charge for these adults.
- Adult: scout ratios required by the BSA are required for all clinics. Tiger Cub programs include scout plus adult partner, as outlined by the BSA.
- Scouts should arrive dressed appropriately to participate in fun, hands-on learning which may include sitting on the floor and using craft supplies such as paint and glue.
- Programs involve a combination of learn-at-your-pace stations and educator-lead activities.
- Registering for any Fox Valley Scout Program Collaboration clinic implies consent for collaborator use of any photographs taken during the clinic. Leaders/parents must advise the clinic leader at least one week before the clinic if there are exceptions.
